The angel Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the House of David; and the virgin's name was Mary. New COVID-19 update

From 1st December 2020 restrictions on church attendance are eased further. The following points are to be observed.

- Churches can follow a two square metre rule. Our Church will now be permitted to have a maximum of 220 people.
- A degree of physical distancing between persons not from the same household should still be encouraged.
- Those who come early please sit in the middle of the pews to make room for others.
- Parishioners are still encouraged to wear face masks when attending Mass.
- Singing by congregations is now permitted.
- Weddings and Funerals should follow the same rules.
- Churches are required to keep records of all attending Masses for contact tracing purposes.
- Those sitting outside must ensure they also register their attendance.
- Use QR code to sign in for faster entry.
- Strict hygiene rules are still required.
- Do not leave any printed materials or loose items lying around please take all your belongings with you.

Dispensation is now lifted.

In light of the significant easing of the restrictions upon church attendance, the Archbishop has now rescinded the decree of 20 March 2020 dispensing the faithful of Sydney from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and the Holy Days of Christmas and the Assumption. **Under canon 1247 attendance at Mass on those days is now obligatory once again**. Of course, we want people to come to Mass out of love more than obedience, but love itself brings responsibilities. Those who are of great age, have health conditions or are otherwise anxious about the risks of COVID-19 are free to remain at home and find another way of keeping holy the Sunday Sabbath. If people find they cannot get in to a particular Mass, they should regard their attempt as satisfying the obligation.

Reflection

God's Grace

One of the challenges of faith is to recognize God's plan for us and to remain open to God's will and God's actions in our world. Filled with God's grace, Mary models for us the kind of faith that is needed to cooperate in God's plan of salvation. Like Mary, we are given the awesome opportunity to cooperate in God's saving plan. On this final Sunday of Advent, our Gospel invites us to consider how our preparations for Christmas have made us more aware of God's grace working in our lives.

Gather together your family and talk about what you have been doing as a family to prepare for Christmas. How have these preparations helped you to better celebrate the central mystery of Christmas, the Incarnation? Our Gospel today talks about how Mary was prepared for her role in Christ's birth. Read today's Gospel, Luke 1:26-38. Consider the question: What enabled Mary to say yes to God? Which of your Advent activities have made you more aware of God's grace in your life? Conclude in prayer together that God's grace will enable your family to be more faithful and obedient to God. Pray together the *Magnificat*.
