

On Friday the 17th of February, 2023, the Parish launched its Inaugural MacKillop Teens Group, named after Australia's first and only Saint, Mary of the Cross MacKillop. The group was started in order to create a community within the Parish that helps teenagers encounter and foster a relationship with God and His Church, and form authentic friendships that will encourage virtuous living.

The opening night was a huge success, drawing in 21 teens ranging from 12 – 17 years old. Fr Van and Fr Will, along with some Youth volunteers led the attendees through a number of games in order to get to know one another, before breaking out into small groups to better familiarise themselves with their peers and discuss their hopes for the group. The night ended with a delicious BBQ dinner, organised and prepared by generous Parish volunteers and parents of our teens.

The MacKillop Teens nights are held every 3rd Friday of the month from 6:00pm – 8:00pm, with the next meeting scheduled for Friday the 17th of March. At just 16 years old, she had to leave school after falling pregnant with her first child. A single mother struggling with homelessness, Tereesa's only concern was finding stability for her children.

Seeking a better future for her family, Tereesa joined Baabayn Aboriginal Corporation's Young Mums and Bubs Group, supported by Caritas Australia. Baabayn helped Tereesa access housing and psychological support. Today, Tereesa is studying a certificate in Community Services so that she can strengthen her skills and give back to her community.
